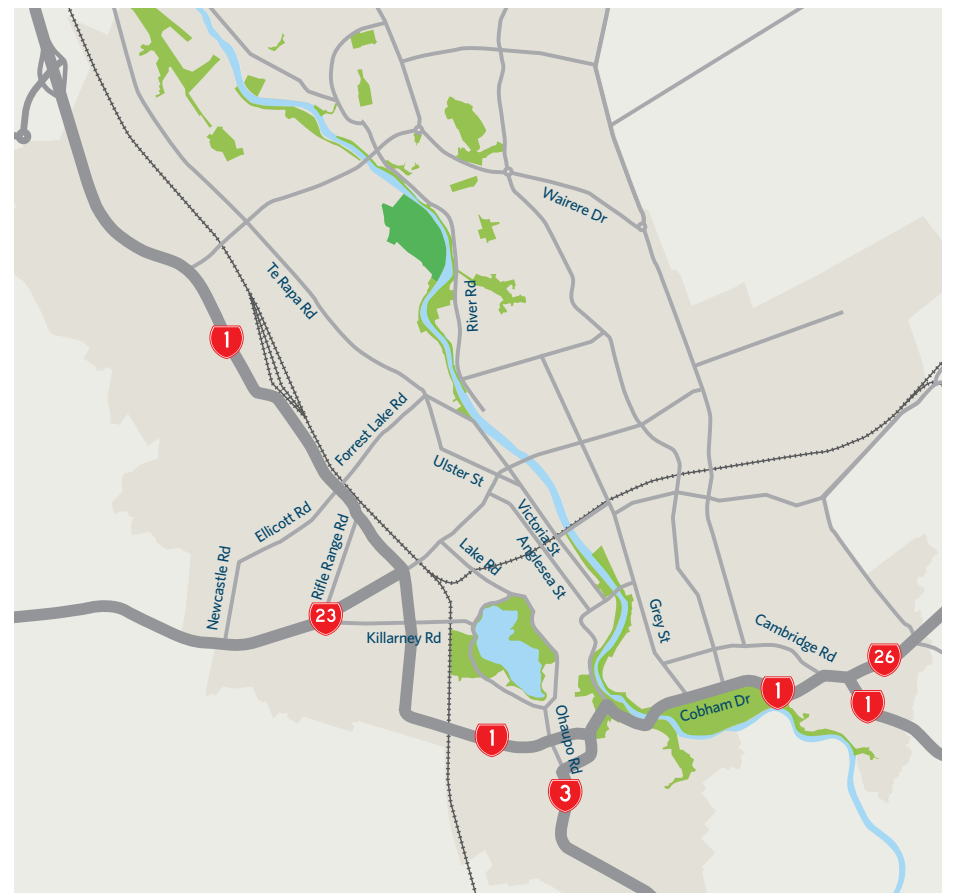


Have your say on state highways accessibility
